We intended to publish this guide after five years of establishing the college itself because of its high role in motivating students to develop their levels and abilities of study in social, scientific and educational fields.


We therefore performed this first guide to let others be acquainted closely with this college.



Secondly: providing the students by the most modern information and discoveries in their fields.





### **Management Affair Section:**

Management affair section is regarded as one of the most important sections in Al-Noor University College which is associated directly with the dean. It includes excellent well-trained employees.

It is regarded as one of the basic administrative sections in the college and the first episode, out of which all the administrative and legal procedures are started regarding employing and the procedures which follow it during their existence in the establishment. Furthermore, to print and issue letters and instructions which determine the boundaries of work and

transfer decisions and instructions to the staff.

#### The Tasks:

First: Administrating human resources affairs in the College.

Second: Organizing and functionalizing personal files, and preparing full data of the permanent and temporary staff.

#### **Registering Branch and Students Affairs:**

This branch has started its business since 2013-2014 where every thing is related to receiving, registering students and accepting them. Actually this branch continued well. About 662 male and female students were accepted at that time, and were distributed to many different departments: (Law, English, Arabic, and Physical Education, morning and evening studies of first grade).

We soon found a solution to our students after their migration to different Iraqi provinces north and south of it. Therefore, they ended their final year Examination (2013-2014).

Co-Operative process with official:

Universities appreciated this by

the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, Private Teaching.

In 2014-2015, the Formal study continued in Al-Noor College in replaced building at Al-Sheikhan province. About (173) students were accepted to be distributed in all departments. The study thus has been continued in this building for two years until the liberation of Nenevah Governorate.

After the liberation of all Nenevah parts including Bertla province, the new building was completely prepared and students were accepted in 2017-2018.

Here, New Scientific departments were opened (Dentistry: morning study), Pathology morning and evening study, Pathology is considered one of the departments of the Techniques of Medicine. In this respect, six hundred and ninety two students male and female were accepted.

This department continues successfully its work.

Registering Branch and Students Affairs are now ready to present all logistic requirements, Teaching Staff, and Cadres received successfully the 2018-2019 students in Al-Noor College area.

It should be mentioned that new departments will be opened as: (Pharmacy, Radiology, Anaeshesia, Dental Industry and Optics).






The physical education Dept. Founded in 26/5/2013 according to the ministerial order GH/2677 issued by the ministry of Higher Education and scientific research. 249 students registered in the first year. Then, the department moved to Al-shekhan district as a result of ISIS control on

Bartilla district. The number of enrolled students reduced to (19) and the number of the graduates in the 4th year has become (109).

The Physical Education Dept. turned back to Bartilla after the libration of Mosul. During the studying year 2017-2018, (130) students were enrolled after the return of many of displaced and liberated students. Thirty six students graduated last year. (81) students nowadays are registered in the first and second stages. Some students are waiting for the new studying year (2018-2019) to register in this department.

-1To provide students with academic, educational, social and moral qualification to lead and develop their society.










The department aspires to graduate a group of competent and distinguished dentists to take their active role in treating patients with various specialties of dentists at the level of the country.




