13 CLIMATE ACTION

AL-Noor University has launched a campaign to plant 1,000 trees along a 5-kilometer stretch in collaboration with the "Muthabirun for Development and Environment" Foundation, with the generous participation of university students and faculty. The campaign was launched under the slogan "Plant a seedling in your name or in the name of someone you love," under the patronage and presence of Dr. Ahmed Al-Hasood, President of the Nineveh Provincial Council, and Deputy Council President Mr. Mohammed Al-Jubouri. Mr. Al-Jubouri inaugurated the campaign with a speech in which he praised initiatives aimed at enhancing green cover and creating a safe, clean environment, and he commended Noor University's initiative to carry out a large-scale planting campaign along the central median on the Mosul Road leading to Al-Shalalat.
