

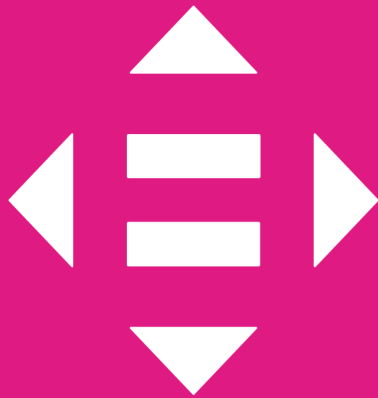

10 REDUCED INEQUALITIES
